## **WILD in the Community**

Sometimes it is not feasible to bring a group to the Welsh Mountain Zoo. We offer Outreach Visits to schools, businesses, nursing homes and community groups where the Education Manager can bring a selection of animals for handling and provide an informative session based on your groups needs and requirements.

Our Education Manager is available to make outside visits to schools and other groups in the Zoo's quieter season between September and Easter.

### **For Playgroups, Schools and Colleges:**

Almost all the topics on offer at the Zoo can also be done as outreach, and can be used as an introduction or conclusion to a classroom topic. Biofacts will be brought along to illustrate the topic and some Animals may also be brought to enhance the experience (conditions apply). The Education Manager is also available for assemblies and fairs.

### **For Community Groups:**

We can attend local Community Group meetings for talks about the History of the Zoo, Why Zoo's are important or any other conservation or wildlife based topics you might find of interest. Animals and Biofacts may be brought along to illustrate the talk (conditions apply).

### **For Residential Care Homes:**

We offer Animal Handling sessions for local residential care homes. It has been proven that contact with animals is a relaxing form of therapy and while many residents may have owned a dog or cat, we can provide some furry (and not so furry) friends that they may not have had contact with previously.

## **Terms and Conditions**

The Zoo must receive payment and completed paperwork at least 2 weeks in advance of the visit.

Prices are £50 for a Half Day (up to 4 hours) and £100 for a Full Day (between 4-8 hours, inclusive of travel time.)

Fee paid for outreach visit (minus mileage) can be refunded off the total cost of admission if a visit to the Zoo is arranged within 12 months of the outreach visit.

Free mileage up to 20 miles from the Zoo, 35p per mile thereafter.

Animal handling sessions are limited to a 20 mile radius from the Zoo within Zoo operating hours (at the Education Managers discretion)

Wherever possible, live animals are used to enhance the experience, so please check to see if any of your group have allergies or phobias before your visit. Please speak to the Education Manager BEFORE your visit if you have any concerns about animal handling.

### **For playgroup, school and college bookings:**

The recommended maximum number of pupils per active session is limited to 30 under the age of 10, 20 over the age of 10. Larger groups can either book multiple active sessions or assembly type talks. Please see our WILD Sessions Booking form for a list of sessions we offer, or contact the Education Manager to discuss your requirements.

### **For Community Group bookings:**

Please ensure that for all "talks" you inform the Education Manager if they are required to bring a laptop, projector, screen. For any Outdoor Events, we will require space for a Gazebo, table and chairs, as well as parking next to the designated area.
