

Fundraising Volunteers

Volunteers will assist with any fundraising projects around the Zoo or in the local community. These might be for specific Zoo projects (enclosure improvements), BIAZA/EAZA/ WAZA Campaigns, or any other charitable cause that match the aims and objectives of the National Zoo for Wales.

Duties

- Organising fundraising events at the Zoo
- Organising fundraising events outside the Zoo
- Running a book or plant stall during busy periods
- Selling raffle tickets
- Designing promotional posters for fundraising events
- Approaching local businesses for support
- Exploring new avenues for fundraising

Timings

This role is flexible, but volunteers are expected to complete a minimum for 2 hours a week. Suitable for those wishing to volunteer from home, but volunteers should check in on a monthly basis.

Skills required

- Good communication
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Interest in the Conservation work at the Zoo
- Creative skills desirable
- Previous fundraising experience also beneficial

Health and Safety training will be provided
All volunteer roles in the Education Department are subject to DBS checks. Volunteers must provide the Education Officer with the appropriate documentation when requested, prior to start date. Failure to comply with this will result in delayed start dates.
